**Objective:** To explore Godly Leadership and success in Nehemiah.

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### Background of Nehemiah:

92 years since the Jew returned from Babylon, 70 Years - Rebuilt,  
12 Years - Ezra launched a revival

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### **Nehemiah**

1 It came to pass in the month of Chisleu, in the twentieth year, as I was in Shushan the citadel, 2 that Hanani one of my brethren came with men from Judah; and I asked them concerning the Jews who had escaped, who had survived the captivity, and concerning Jerusalem. 3 And they said to me, "The survivors who are left from the captivity in the province are there in **great trouble and disgrace**. The wall of Jerusalem is also broken down, and its gates are burned with fire." (140 years) 4 When I heard these things, that I sat down and wept, and mourned for some days; I was mourned and fasting and praying before the God of heaven. (4 month gap) 5 Then I said: "I pray, Lord God of heaven, O great and awesome God, You who keep Your covenant and mercy with those who love You and observe Your commandments,

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11 O Lord, I pray, please let Your ear be attentive to the prayer of Your servant, and to the prayer of Your servants who desire to fear Your name; and let Your servant success today, I pray, and grant him favor in the sight of this man." For I was the king's cupbearer.

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### Chapter 2

1 And it came to pass in the month of Nisan, in the twentieth year of King Artaxerxes, when wine was before him, that I took the wine and gave it to the king. I had never been sad in his presence before. 2 Therefore the king said to me, "Why is your face sad, since you are not sick? This is nothing but sorrow of heart." So I became dreadfully afraid, 3 and said to the king, "May the king live forever! Why should my face not be sad, when the city, the place of my fathers' tombs, lies waste, and its gates are burned with fire?" 4 Then the king said to me, "What do you request?" So I prayed to the God of heaven. 5 And I said to the king, "If it pleases the king, and if your servant has found favor in your sight, I ask that you send me to Judah, to the city of my fathers' tombs, that I may rebuild it." 6 Then the king said to me (the queen also sitting beside him), "How long will your journey be? And when will you return?" So it pleased the king to send me; and I set him a time. 7 Furthermore I said to the king, "If it pleases the king, let letters be given to me for the governors of the region beyond the River, that they must permit me to pass through till I come to Judah, 8 and a letter to Asaph the keeper of the king's forest, that he must give me timber to make beams for the gates of the citadel which pertains to the temple, for the city wall, and for the house that I will occupy." And the king granted them to me according to the good hand of my God upon me.

### **Nehemiah 2:17-18**

Then I said to them, you see the trouble we are in. Jerusalem lies in ruins and its gates have been burned with fire. Come let us rebuild the walls of Jerusalem.

#### NOTES:

- Don't let me ever hear you give any orders.
- Key to grasp that you are building teams
- The more authority you have the less you have to give orders.
- The skill of Asking
- Authority will never make people responsive.

### **Nehemiah 3 "The Ledger of Team Building"**

**1** Then Eliashib the high priest and the other priests started to rebuild at the Sheep Gate. They dedicated it and set up its doors, building the wall as far as the Tower of the Hundred, which they dedicated, and the Tower of Hananel. **2** People from the city of Jericho worked next to them, and beyond them was Zaccur son of Imri. **3** The Fish Gate was built by the sons of Hassenaah. They did the whole thing - laid the beams, hung the doors, and put the bolts and bars in place. **4** Meremoth son of Uriah and grandson of Hakkoz repaired the next section of wall. Beside him were Meshullam son of Berekiah and grandson of Meshezabel, and then Zadok son of Baana. **5** Next were the people from Tekoa, though their leaders refused to help. **6** The Old City Gate was repaired by Joiada son of Paseah and Meshullam son of Besodeiah. They laid the beams, set up the doors, and installed the bolts and bars. **7** Next to them were Melatiah from Gibeon, Jadon from Meronoth, and people from Gibeon and Mizpah, the headquarters of the governor of the province west of the Euphrates River. **8** Next was Uzziel son of Harhaiah, a goldsmith by trade, who also worked on the wall. Beyond him was Hananiah, a manufacturer of perfumes. They left out a section of Jerusalem as far as the Broad Wall. **9** Rephaiah son of Hur, the leader of half the district of Jerusalem, was next to them on the wall. **10** Next Jedaiah son of Harumaph repaired the wall beside his own house, and next to him was Hattush son of Hashabneiah. **11** Then came Malkijah son of Harim and Hasshub son of Pahath-moab, who repaired the Tower of the Ovens, in addition to another section of the wall. **12** Shallum son of Hallohesh and his daughters repaired the next section. He was the leader of the other half of the district of Jerusalem. **13** The people from Zanoah, led by Hanun, rebuilt the Valley Gate, hung its doors, and installed the bolts and bars. They also repaired the fifteen hundred feet of wall to

the Dung Gate. **14** The Dung Gate was repaired by Malkijah son of Recab, the leader of the Beth-hakkerem district. After rebuilding it, he hung the doors and installed the bolts and bars. **15** Shallum son of Col-hozeh, the leader of the Mizpah district, repaired the Fountain Gate. He rebuilt it, roofed it, hung its doors, and installed its bolts and bars. Then he repaired the wall of the pool of Siloam near the king's garden, and he rebuilt the wall as far as the stairs that descend from the City of David. **16** Next to him was Nehemiah son of Azbuk, the leader of half the district of Beth-zur. He rebuilt the wall to a place opposite the royal cemetery as far as the water reservoir and the House of the Warriors. **17** Next was a group of Levites working under the supervision of Rehum son of Bani. Then came Hashabiah, the leader of half the district of Keilah, who supervised the building of the wall on behalf of his own district. **18** Next down the line were his countrymen led by Binnui son of Henadad, the leader of the other half of the district of Keilah. **19** Next to them, Ezer son of Jeshua, the leader of Mizpah, repaired another section of wall opposite the armory by the buttress. **20** Next to him was Baruch son of Zabbai, who repaired an additional section from the buttress to the door of the home of Eliashib the high priest. **21** Meremoth son of Uriah and grandson of Hakkoz rebuilt another section of the wall extending from a point opposite the door of Eliashib's house to the side of the house. **22** Then came the priests from the surrounding region. **23** After them, Benjamin, Hasshub, and Azariah son of Maaseiah and grandson of Ananiah repaired the sections next to their own houses. **24** Next was Binnui son of Henadad, who rebuilt another section of the wall from Azariah's house to the buttress and the corner. **25** Palal son of Uzai carried on the work from a point opposite the buttress and the corner to the upper tower that projects from the king's house beside the court of the guard. Next to him were Pedaiah son of Parosh **26** and the Temple servants living on the hill of Ophel, who repaired the wall as far as the Water Gate toward the east and the projecting tower. **27** Then came the people of Tekoa, who repaired another section opposite the great projecting tower and over to the wall of Ophel. **28** The priests repaired the wall up the hill from the Horse Gate, each one doing the section immediately opposite his own house. **29** Next Zadok son of Immer also rebuilt the wall next to his own house, and beyond him was Shemaiah son of Shecaniah, the gatekeeper of the East Gate. **30** Next Hananiah son of Shelemiah and Hanun, the sixth son of Zalaph, repaired another section, while Meshullam son of Berekiah rebuilt the wall next to his own house. **31** Malkijah, one of the goldsmiths, repaired the wall as far as the housing for the Temple servants and merchants, opposite the Inspection Gate. Then he continued as far as the upper room at the corner. **32** The other goldsmiths and merchants repaired the wall from that corner to the Sheep Gate.

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### Nehemiah's Leadership Nuggets

1. He knew them by name and personally
2. He let them build by their homes
3. When they couldn't repair next to their homes, he let them repair next to their jobs.
4. He praised those who didn't live in Jerusalem, and he made their journey shorter.
5. He arranged it to work near their friends

**BOTTOM LINE:** Nehemiah cared so deeply that everyone felt they had the best spot on the team.

### 📖 Notes from Nehemiah 4 \_\_\_\_\_

- Sanballat (governor of Samaria) was mad and encouraged his army and mocked Nehemiah
- Nehemiah's response was to pray, and be concerned for his men.
- People worked with all of their heart
- Samaria declared war. Threats of attacks
- Build scaffolding to the top half of the wall.
- Half of the men had to stand guard.

### Nehemiah 5 \_\_\_\_\_

- Internal Strife in homes, financial burden, and selling children.
- Integrity of Nehemiah in dealing with the conflict.

### Nehemiah 6 \_\_\_\_\_

- Distractions reveal the purposes of God.
- I am carrying doing a great project, so that I cannot come down; why should the work cease, while I leave it and come down to you?
- Plotting against Nehemiah with lies.
- Nehemiah's response
- Prophetic friends were given false words.

Look at the miraculous manner that this was accomplished with Jesus, and then realize the significance of what Jesus did on our behalf.

**Objective:** To share how the revival was birthed during the time of Nehemiah and encounter God.

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One to Two weeks after the wall was completed.



Nehemiah 8: 1-10

**1** "All the people, as one man in a square, assembled before the Water Gate. They asked Ezra the scribe to bring out the Book of the Law of Moses, which the LORD had commanded for Israel. **2** So on first day of the seventh month, Ezra the priest brought the law before the assembly, which included the men and women who were all able to understand. **3** He read aloud from daybreak until noon, as he faced the square before the Water Gate to everyone who could understand. All the people paid close attention to the Book of the Law. **4** Ezra the scribe stood on a high wooden platform that had been made for the occasion. Beside him on his right stood Mattithiah, Shema, Anaiah, Uriah, Hilkiah, and Maaseiah. To his left stood Pedaiah, Mishael, Malkijah, Hashum, Hashbaddanah, Zechariah, and Meshullam. **5** Ezra opened the book and all of the people could see him because he was standing above them as he opened it, the people all stood up. **6** Ezra praised the LORD, the great God, and all the people lifted their hands and responded, "Amen! Amen!". Then they bowed down and worshiped the LORD with their faces to the ground. **7** The Levites - Jeshua, Bani, Sherebiah, Jamin, Akkub, Shabbethai, Hodiah, Maaseiah, Kelita, Azariah, Jozabad, Hanan, and Pelaiah - instructed the people in the law while they were standing there. **8** They read from the Book of the Law of God making it clear and giving the meaning, so that the people could understand what was being read. **9** Then Nehemiah the governor, Ezra the priest and scribe, and the Levites who were instructing the people said to them, "This day is sacred to the LORD your God. Do not mourn or weep." For all the people had been weeping as they listened to the words of the law. **10** And Nehemiah said, "Go and enjoy choice foods and sweet drinks, and send some to those who have nothing prepared. This is a sacred day to the Lord. Don't be do not grieve for the joy of the LORD is your strength!"

#### Helpless

- If I don't get strength from God, I will make serious error and it will take months to repair.
- Joy of the Lord is your strength, "Total helplessness"

#### Able

- Saved, they will do it in their own strength. They live their lives by a curse word, "should".
- Sour people and overwhelmed

### Nehemiah 9:38-39

"In view of all this, putting it in writing, and leaders, Levites, and fixing their seals to it."

### Covenant Agreement

- Will not let their children marry anyone who didn't believe in God
- First fruit, First born cattle, First grain, new wine, and oil, & Tithe

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**Daily Study of God's Word = Hunger**

**Faithfully Tithing = Lordship**

**Q:** What is Satan's most powerful tool against Christians? (Matt.6: 24)
